

The Sources of the *Canons of Edgar*

For practical reasons, scriptural parallels are ignored. Standard short titles for Old English works are used, except that ‘*Canons*’ is used for the *Canons of Edgar*. Short titles for Latin texts are of my own invention. Depending on the layout of the editions, titles are followed by, where appropriate, book number (in Roman numerals), and (in Arabic numerals) the chapter, section, and/or the line number where the relevant passage *begins*; but references to chapter 145 of *Aachen* are given with page and line numbers. The evaluation of each source is indicated following the short title by a siglum (in bold) which is based on the scheme developed by the *Fontes Anglo-Saxonici* online database.¹ These sigla are preceded by an ‘x’ when the source is relevant to readings in the X version of the *Canons* only. Source texts are selected and evaluated using a number of criteria, most importantly parallels in wording (insofar as these are identifiable when the source text is Latin) and in theme, but also contiguity of relevant chapters in the source and/or target text (i.e. the *Canons*). The importance of this last factor is signalled at the end of the source-list by a list of possible sequences of borrowing. In evaluating sources I have given precedence to texts Wulfstan is known to have used or had available to him during his lifetime. As many medieval canons can ultimately be traced back to the more ancient collections, I have not endeavoured to give all antecedent sources (‘SA’), except where I have felt such information is of relevance. Analogues (‘SX’), too, are only given where they are felt to be relevant. Wulfstan’s own works are sometimes sources for the *Canons*. In such cases I follow Pons-Sanz’ chronology² and ignore as a possible source any work of Wulfstan’s that is judged to be later than the *Canons*; however, exceptions are made for *LawEGu* and chapters 1-45 of *LawNorthu*, as it seems to me that Wulfstan may have written these texts before the *Canons*. Sources are listed in order of relevance. Note that a text’s inclusion in this list does not guarantee Wulfstan knew it or used it in the *Canons*, as some parallels will surely be accidental. It is acknowledged that a list such as this one will inevitably be subject to revision as more becomes known about Wulfstan’s works and manuscripts.
